APPLICATION

When worn correctly and given adequate care these Ear Plugs provide excellent protection by filtering high frequency noises from dynamic machines such as workshop equipment and power saws, etc.

Requirements: This hearing protector complies with the requirements of the European Directive 89/686/EEC annex II by means of the European standard EN352-2 "Hearing protectors- safety requirements and testing Part 2- Ear Plug".

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Fit the neck string along the rear of the neck, positioning each ear plug on both sides of your head.
2. Access each ear canal by reaching over your head with the opposite hand and gently pulling each ear outward.
3. Place the smaller flange in each ear canal, gently push and twist towards the rear centre of your head until a snug, firm seal is made.
4. Ear plugs do tend to work loose as a result of talking or chewing and must be resealed.
Put the ear plugs in before exposing yourself to noise, and wear them during the whole noise exposure.

RECOMMENDATION

1. Ensure the re-usable ear plugs are fitted, adjusted and maintained in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.
2. The re-usable ear plugs must be worn at all times in noisy surroundings.
3. The re-usable ear plugs are regularly inspected for service ability.

CARING FOR YOUR EAR PLUGS

Cleaning:

Clean with warm soapy water, do not use organic solvents or alcohol for cleaning.

Disinfection:

1. It is required to disinfect the ear plugs after using for certain periods.
2. Any part of the ear plugs that are in contact with the wearer should be disinfected.

Storage:

When not in use, keep the ear plugs with the neck string in a plastic carrying box (as supplied) for future use. Ensure the plugs and string are dry when returned to the box.
